After the Civil War, the United States government recognized the need for major geographic and geologic surveys of the West and established four surveys. Dr. Ferdinand V. Hayden, a geologist and physician, led the survey of Colorado. The resulting publication of *Geological and Geographical Atlas of Colorado and Portions of Adjacent Territory* in 1877 made Colorado the best-mapped state in the Union at that time.

Christopher Lane's presentation will detail the history of the survey and its seminal maps.

Christopher Lane is the founder of Philadelphia Print Shop West, a gallery in Denver specializing in antique prints, maps and related books. He has given lectures around the country on historic prints, including many on maps and views of the American West. He has also curated a number of print and map exhibits and is the author of numerous articles and books. He served for 22 years as an appraiser on Antiques Roadshow and is active in numerous print and map societies.
